BILL

to amend the Essential Articles Control and Requisitioning
(Temporary Powers) Act, 1949.

Preamble.—WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Essential Articles Control and Requisitioning (Temporary Powers) Act, 1949, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) This Act may be called the Essential Articles Control and Requisitioning (Temporary Powers) Amendment Act, 1958.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. *Amendment of section 1.*— In sub-section (3) of section 1 of the Essential Articles Control and Requisitioning (Temporary Powers) Act, 1949 (Act XXIX of 1949), for the words, figures and letters “the 25th January 1959”, the words, figures and letters “the 25th January 1960” shall be substituted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The period of operation of the Essential Articles Control and Requisitioning (Temporary Powers) Act, 1949, is due to expire on the 25th January 1959. It is considered necessary to extend the operation of the Act for a further period of one year. The Bill is intended for this purpose.

Extract from the Madras Essential Articles Control and
